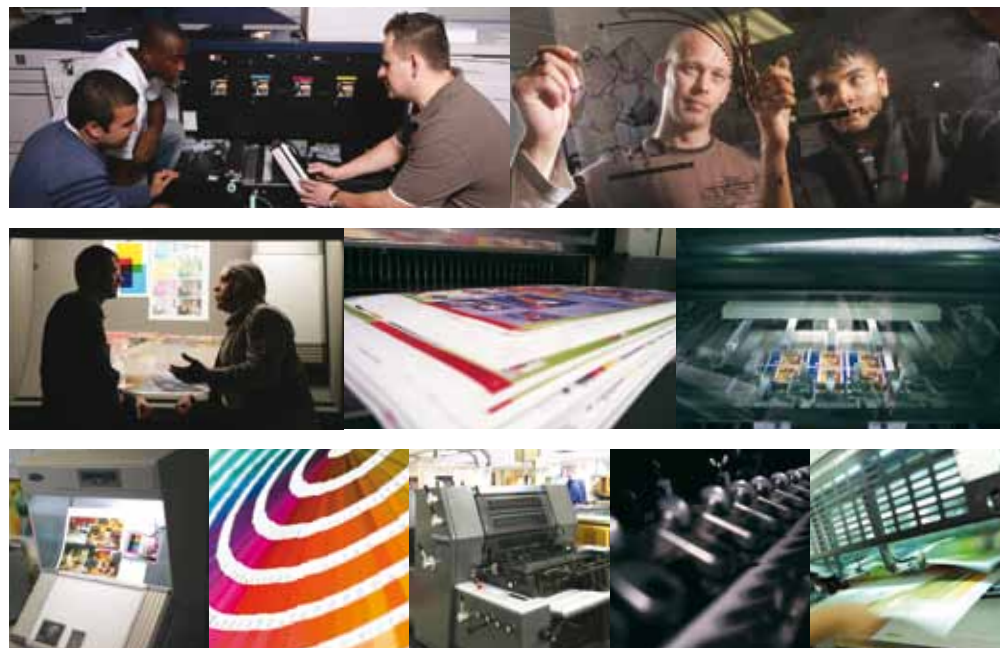
Previous learners have progressed to "top-up" to a BA or BSc (Hons) Degree or found employment at middle to senior level in industry, management or teaching.

## What is this course about?

This qualification has been designed with the print industry to develop the skills and knowledge needed in this sector. The course is ideal if you want to enhance your career in printing and achieve a managerial position.

The course covers a range of vocational training and management techniques, studied alongside work experience and evaluation. Some modules can also be offered as one-off stand-alone modules, though ideally you will opt to study a series of modules.

## What do I need to start?

You require a minimum of 80 UCAS points in one of the following in a Printing, Science or related subject, plus four GCSEs at grade C or above to include Maths and English:

- BTEC National Diploma or Certificate
- Advanced GNVQ
- NVQ level 3
- one A level
- or a qualification equivalent to the above.

You will need to attend an interview for this course. For overseas and mature learners' entry requirements, please see the "How to Apply" pages.

## How long is the course?

Two years full-time.  
Three years, part-time.

## How will I be assessed?

Assessment is a combination of practical and research-based assignments.

## What is the fee?

## What can I progress to?
