What do I need to start?

You will need four GCSEs at grade C or above, plus one of the following:

- A level or AVCE in Art and Design
- a suitable National Diploma.

A portfolio of work is required at interview.

We welcome applications from adult learners who do not match the standard entry requirements but who can demonstrate commitment to studying this subject at University level, and who can evidence academic or vocational experience in a related field.

How long is the course?

One year, full-time.

How will I be assessed?

Assessment is continuous throughout the year.

What is the fee?
